

Sacramento Continuum of Care Advisory Board Seeking Member with Lived Experience

The Continuum of Care Advisory Board is comprised of up to 25 members focused on issues related to the homeless housing crisis resolution system in Sacramento. Members include nonprofit providers, advocates, people with lived experience of homelessness, local government, business community, and others. Monthly meetings focus on things like preparing for and conducting the annual competition for federal funding from HUD, discussing new government initiatives to address homelessness, the performance on Sacramento's coordinated entry system, and many other topics related to homelessness.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must come from a household who has past or current experience living in homelessness with minor children
- Ability to work effectively on a team
- Capacity to read and assess detailed information

REQUIREMENTS

- Regular attendance and participation in board activities. Members must actively participate in a minimum of 50% of meetings.

PROCESS

Interested individuals will fill out a Declaration of Interest which will be evaluated by the Nominating Committee and one (1) candidate will be selected for recommendation. The recommendation will be presented and approved by the Advisory Board.

The selected and approved candidate will have transportation provided if needed.

Board Members terms are for two (2) years and renewable for two (2) additional terms.
