# What is a Continuum of Care?



**A Continuum of Care (CoC)** is a regional or local planning body that coordinates housing and services to meet the specific needs of people experiencing homelessness as they move to

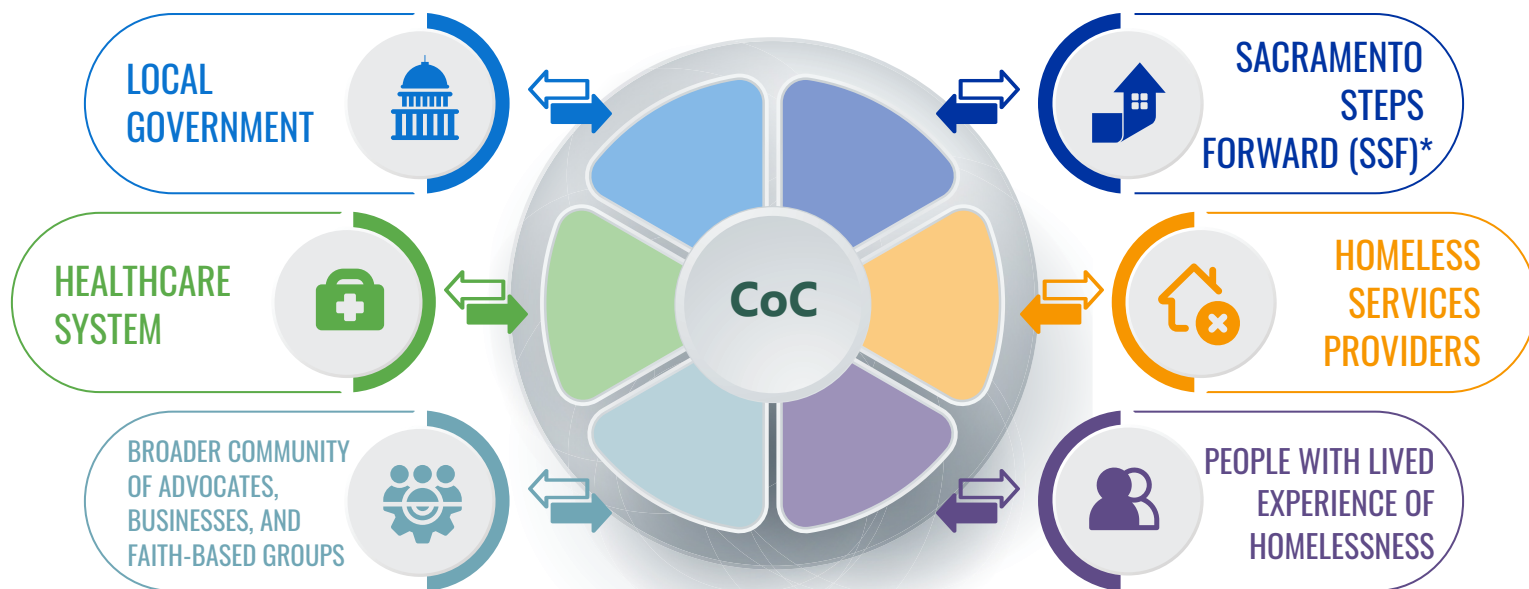
## Who comprises the Sacramento CoC?

The Sacramento City and County Continuum of Care (Sacramento CoC) has a **30-member board** which includes representation from local government, homeless services providers, people with lived experience, and the broader community of businesses, advocates, and faith-based groups.



## Where is the Sacramento CoC situated in the community?

The Sacramento CoC is situated at a nexus for homelessness related efforts and is both informed by and helps to inform the work of our community partners.
