- Bridget/Geoffrey to reach out to YAB to gauge interest in joining the CoC PRC (Keep in mind: how much service time do they have on YAB to ensure they do not term out on the YAB, consider an eligibility requirement of having served on the YAB for at least a year before being recommended to the PRC, so that YAB are familiar with the CoC and PRC).

Jesse discussed the Scoring Tool Review worksheet:

- <u>Increase or Maintain Income</u>: no feedback provided.
- Housing Retention: SF's youth specific metric was discussed. There are not a lot of changes for us in this category.
 - How will TH-RRH programs be scored since HMIS sets these programs up as two separate programs, when in reality they are funded as a single program.
 - Recommendation: Invite/Discuss with HMIS Team (David, Tina) to discuss this item.

- Geoffrey or Jesse met on Mon, 3/24/25 with a new TA and will meet with the TA until June 2025 for additional guidance (TA has 5-10 hours per month).
 - Recommendation: The PRC is welcome to share questions with Geoffrey or Jesse to pass along to the TA to ensure PRC questions are addressed.
- <u>Severity of Needs & Special Considerations:</u> like the LAHSA, only 3 tools were specifically for this topic.
 - o This metric usually gets full points for all applicants due to its vagueness
 - The group considered removing
 - Discussion on "Does your project accept EVH referrals through CAS?...# of CAS assessors?"
 - Recommendation: bring this to the SSF CAS Team or CASC for their recommendation (HCT).
- BONUS: Organization Commitment to Racial Equity:
 - A note was shared that given the current uncertainty with the Federal Government; things may change in the upcoming months we may need to adjust.
 - Aziz shared the SSF Data/HMIS Team can provide weighted factors, we currently look at the head of households.
 - Recommendation: bring this to the SSF Data/HMIS Team for their recommendation on what we can do here.
 - Recommendation: bring this to the CoC REQC for their recommendation on what we can do here. A joint meeting with PRC + REQC could be helpful (Summer 2025, until we have more concrete knowledge of where we are with this).
