## A Strategy for Addressing Homelessness

The All In Sacramento plan builds upon the 2022 Local Homeless Action Plan that created a regional partnership, established strategies, set benchmarks, and met state funding requirements. This next phase features eight core solutions that represent more targeted components of an effective and coordinated system. Key actions in each of these areas will help the Sacramento community achieve its vision of making homelessness rare, brief, and non-recurring.

## Key Strategies

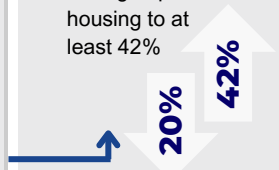
- Continue to improve the countywide Coordinated Access System by building capacity to the 2-1-1 (#8) Housing Crisis Line and by adding physical access points
- Establish a Coordinated Prevention Core Team for the region, with a priority on involving people with lived experience.
- Establish a multi-year plan to increase the community's ability to rapidly rehouse persons experiencing homelessness
- Improve access to resources across systems including, for instance, behavioral health, hospitals, jails, public benefits, and employment
- Implement a pilot program to identify the most frequently served individuals across systems and provide individualized support

### Transforming our system by:

- Investing in and coordinating efforts to prevent homelessness,
- Fundamentally reorienting our system's focus on Rehousing, and
- Ensuring consistent and equitable access to quality person-centered care.

### In order to:

- Reduce the number of people experiencing unsheltered homelessness by 20%,
- Increase the percentage of people exiting to permanent housing to at least 42%



### So that we can realize our vision:

- A person-centered, trauma-informed regional response system where **homelessness is rare, brief, and non-recurring.**
