SSF Staff are waiting for the release of the 2024 CoC Program NOFO by HUD, SSF Staff is working on a RFI for this year's competition relating to the scoring criteria, and until the 2024 NOFO is released we are preparing. She shared an overview on the NOFO, that we are transitioning to every other year cycle (currently annually), this is a core focus for the CoC Board, we compete for funds by submitting Renewal and New Project applications for Permeant Housing Programs for people who are experiencing homeless, and submit a Community Narrative/Application about what we are doing locally. The NOFO is a large competition that supports many of Sacramento's PSH, RRH, TH projects, HMIS, CE, and Planning. Learn more about last year's 2023 NOFO here.

Trent shared a <u>presentation</u>, discussing What is the PIT Count?, Sacramento January 2024 PIT Count, Estimated Counts for a Point in Time in January 2024, 2024 Demographics, Sheltered vs. Unsheltered Compositions, Unsheltered Distribution, Insights from survey responses during the PIT Count, Homelessness is declining in Sacramento County and much of Northern California, Collaboration and investment have increased across the homelessness response system, Capacity has increased, System outcomes have improved, The rental market has improved, making housing more accessible, Investments and partnerships are impactful.
